Scores are this measure are created by adding each participant response to create a total score below.

Possible responses to each question are scored 0, 1, 2, 3 or 4, with the exception of question 8, which has possible responses of 0, 2 and 4.

Description	Score
Non-Clinical	0
Low Risk	1-7
Moderate Risk	8-11
Severe Risk	12+

NOTE: Some newer research suggests that the cut off score for a severe risk may be lower than 12 for women participants.
