General Info

The SCARED assesses the presence and severity of anxiety symptoms. This is a screening measure that asks individuals to describe these concerns in the past 3 months.

The descriptive classifications are provided are a guideline. These results are not clinical diagnoses. Please see the provided resources for more information about the measure development.

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Screen for Child Anxiety Related Disorders

Item scores are calculated using the following response guide. A total score is created by adding each individual participant response score.

- O Not true or hardly true
- 1 Somewhat true or sometimes true
- 2 Very true or often true

A total score greater or equal to 25 may indicate the presence of anxiety-related concerns that require further treatment.

Each of the 5 subscales can be created by summing participant scores from the specific items listed below. If that score is nigher than the cut off score, the individual may have specific concerns in that subscale domain.
